The service has been designed with growth in mind, continually adding meaningful applications such as on-screen continual display of glucose levels and alerting caregivers of potentially critical situations. The issues families face are universal—just like televisions. This is reflected in the support for a wide range of languages for TV's located worldwide.

More Than Just a Medical Tool

TV Messenger is also ideal for busy families. Parents can send messages like "Do your homework", "Walk the dog", or "Turn on the oven" without relying on phones or text messages, which children often ignore.

Helping Caregivers Support Loved Ones

More than 10 million Americans currently serve as unpaid caregivers, often without the tools they need to manage daily responsibilities. TV Messenger helps reduce that burden by enabling customizable, escalated reminders.
